receive No. 5, and the only private citizen to outrank all members of the cabinet. Atterbury also receives license No. 55.

A. M. Greenfield, Philadelphia real estate dealer and politician with No. 13 and Robert P. Hooper, also of Philadelphia with No. 14, will outrank several of the cabinet members.

Three former governors are included in the list. Their numbers will be as follows — Gifford Pinchot, No. 11, John K. Tener, No. 63 and Martin G. Brumbaugh, 96. Mrs. William C. Sproul, widow of the former governor, will receive No. 77.

United States Senator, David A. Reed was assigned both No. 22 and 94. Senator Elect W. S. Vare gets 80.

The Mellon family in Pittsburgh appears five times in the favored 100. A. W. Mellon, secretary of the treasury, gets No. 48 and W. I. Mellon, his nephew and former Republican State Chairman No. 26, Helen Mellon was assigned 33, R. D. Mellon, No. 57 and T. A. Mellon, No. 89.
